Wednesday 5th September 2018 8pm "History of Richmond Palace"

Jane Short is one of the Richmond upon Thames Society of Voluntary Guides. She conducts walks in areas of Southwest London and we have commissioned her to speak to us about our neighbouring borough and its Royal connections, reminding us how close we were to the seat of power.

Thursday 8th November 2pm 2018 "Atkinson Morley, Man and Hospital"

Christine Eberhardie is Honorary Principal Lecturer, Kingston and St George's University of London. She taught Neuroscience for over 20 years but was a practitioner at Atkinson Morley from the 1960's. Her talk covers the legacy of Atkinson Morley, the need for a hospital, and its work up to the 21st Century. We consider philanthropy and the roots of the NHS.

Thurs 24th January 2019 2pm "Growing up in Lingfield Road in the 1940s"

Tim Albert's memoir reminds us of Sunnyspread sandwiches and a world without refrigerators, when there were piano lessons from Miss Potts and ballroom dancing lessons in the High Street.

Tim's career spans journalism and training, particularly of the medical profession. He concludes 'Mostly we had it good'. Join him on his journey back to a life in the last century in Wimbledon.

Wednesday 3rd April 2019 8pm "In defence of Emma"

Raglan Tribe is a descendant of one of the best known past local residents. He puts a different perspective on her role in the life of Nelson, our National Naval hero. He is much celebrated with titles, monuments and honours, but what of Lady Hamilton? Raglan informs us about her career and contribution.
