



The Museum's collections include a King's College School cap and tie. There are also other objects a pupil might use: a compass, ruler, ink well, and dip pen.

King's College School was founded in 1829 as part of King's College. In 1897, the school moved to more spacious premises in Wimbledon.

Both the university and the school used the arms of King George IV. That is why there is a lion and crown on the school cap. The school colours are red and blue.
